Aerator Project Cost

- Grant was approved for \$19,356
- Project cost \$18,921.33
- \$4,875 in 'kind hours'
- Reimbursement from DNR

- WPS bill for 1 month and 4 days was \$186

Update on Aerator Project:

The aerator was turned in January of 2022. Per the grant, our Association is responsible for collecting oxygen readings 3 times a year. The 2019 Comprehensive Lake Management Plan report stated that our lake had low to no oxygen in the bottom of our waters and that fish suffer fatalities due to oxygen when the levels fall below 2mg/L. The 2019 report showed that on average our lake was at 1 to 2 mg/L that resulted in winter fish kill. Recent oxygen levels, after putting in the aerator are at 4 mg/L.

The yearly maintenance for the aerator include; oil change every fall, barriers put up every winter and removed in the spring time, and oxygen levels collected 3 times a year. If you are interested in helping or learning more about the maintenance, please reach out to one of
