#### Lake Survey

In February 2017 Little Rice Lake Association had a comprehensive lake management plan done to address two main problems; extensive

aquatic vegetation along the eastern and western shores of the lake that impede navigation and winter fish kills due to low oxygen levels. The private residence along Flowage Lane on the east side and along Yocum Road on the west side have limited to no access to the lake due to thick aquatic vegetation. Lake Association Members have noticed an increase in aquatic vegetation since the original survey that was done in 2017 so the Board Members contracted with Tiffiney Kleczewski to do an another survey for us. The results of the survey can be found out on the Little Rice Lake Website.

#### 4<sup>th</sup> of July Parade

The annual 4<sup>th</sup> of July parade is scheduled for Saturday, July 6<sup>th</sup> at noon. The parade is always a good time, all are welcome to come and get wet and have fun.

### Land Owner Survey

The DNR manages the dam on Little Rice Lake and the 1,200 acreflowage. A DNR permit is required for establishing or changing the level on a lake with a dam. Before Little Rice Lake can petition the DNR for a permit to raise the water level we need to have 100% agreement from the landowners around the lake. Since it has been several years since our last survey, where we failed to get 100% agreement, the board felt it was time to send out another survey. Each landowner / tax parcel will get a chance to voice their opinion, for example if someone owns multiple parcels they will get a survey for each parcel they own and pay taxes on. We are hoping to get 100% agreement to raise the water level an additional 6 inches.
